FIREARMS PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

Application for Firearms Permit must be completed in the Tattnall County Probate Court Office by Applicant in the presence of a Clerk between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Applicant must be a resident of Tattnall County. Proof of Identification and Residency (Driver's License).

Applicant must be 21 years of Age or 18 years of age if applicant is a member of U.S. Armed Forces.

Applicant must pass a Criminal Fingerprint Background Check with GBI, FBI and Local Authorities.

FIREARMS FEES PAYABLE TO TATTNALL COUNTY PROBATE COURT:

FIRST TIME FEE: \$ 72.50

RENEWAL FEE: \$ 30.00

(Renewal Fee applies to licenses that are 90 days before expiration and no later than 30 day after expiration date. If license is expired more than 30 days, renewal fee will not apply and the first time fee will be charged.)

LOST/STOLEN FEE: \$ 6.00

(Replacement of Lost/Stolen Firearms License will required a police or sheriff's department incident report)

RETIRED PEACE OFFICER FEE: \$ 7.00

(Retired Peace Officer Documentation is required)

SHERIFF'S DEPT. FEE: \$ 5.00

(This fee applies for First Time Applicants, Renewal Fee and Retired Peace Officers)
